

Farmhouse Architecture Vocabulary

Porch: A covered shelter projecting in front of the entrance of a building.

Gambrel: A symmetrical two-sided roof with two slopes on each side.

Shutter Dog: Iron pieces attached to a building to hold open the shutters.

Dutch Door: A door that is divided into two horizontal halves that open and close separately.

Chimney: A vertical structure attached to the roof to allow smoke from the fireplace to escape outside.
