- Sells museum admissions and gift shop items to visitors
- Monitor front desk, and ensure adequate supplemental materials are available for visitors
- Assists and answers questions from visitors
- Some administrative projects may arise during this placement

- Ability to interact with customers, coworkers and vendors in a personable and engaging manner
